



## Application for Title for Outboard Motor Changes

If you financed your boat, a lien may be recorded against the boat. If so, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission sent your original title to the lien holder. You are not entitled to possession of the certificate of title until the lien is satisfied. If the lien holder does not have your certificate of title and the lien has been satisfied, you must obtain a letter from the lien holder stating that the lien on your boat has been satisfied.

### Instructions:

- If your boat **does not** have a lien recorded against it, complete Sections A, B and C. Attach original title.
- If your boat **does** have a lien recorded against it, lien holder must complete Sections A, B and C. Attach original title.
- The fee for a corrected title is **\$30.00**.
- Do not send cash. Make your check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.
